## Digital age guide

Internet and mobile safety needs to be timely, age specific, culturally sensitive and match the values of the society in which the child or young person lives.

International Telecommunication Union has identified three principles age groupings of young internet users. These groupings broadly correspond with the key stages of development on a child's journey to adulthood.

Ages 5-7

- First contact with rechnology
- Closely always supervised by adults/Parents
- Filrering software useful for this age group
- Wise to limit access where possible
- Construct a list of safe websites \& Apps


## Ages 8-12

- Challenging transition for the child, grearer capacity to ask questions
- Seek to challenge boundaries
- Impulse to seek and find out what is grear
- Filtering software is critical
- Vulnerable group to predators and commercial entities


## Ages 13+

- Growing up rapidly and transitioning from being young people to being young adults
- High level of digital proficiency withour supervision
- Filtering software less useful
- Monitor remporary or longer-rerm vulnerabilities
- Vulnerable due to natural curiosity
