Accepting invitations & friendships

Reflect before you meet online friends in real life. There is nothing wrong with declining invitations from people you are unsure about.



React

Ignore bad behaviour and leave unpleasant conversations or sites with inappropriate content. Block anyone approaching you in a rude, intruding or threatening manner.



Tell someone your concerns

If you have any concerns or problems while online, you need to tell someone you can trust. Report harmful or inappropriate content.
